Major Project Experience

Industrial Estate, Jamestown

The management of a land division creating 16 allotments in a Light Industrial estate on the outskirts of Jamestown, including the;

- planning of the initial allotment design
- preparation and supervision of the land division application
- field survey work associated with the three dimensional modelling of the site and the definition and marking of the allotment boundaries
- lodgement of the Plan of Sub Division with the Lands Titles Office.

Flood Mitigation Surveys, Jamestown and Gladstone

Supervision of the survey work for flood mitigation surveys in Jamestown and Gladstone. The survey work involved site feature surveys over wide areas of land adjacent to the towns, and the subsequent three dimensional modelling of the land, to facilitate the flood mitigation design work by engineers.

Pelican Point – Blackfellows Caves Road

Liaison with local government and design of a new road alignment for a 7km section of new road between Pelican Point and Blackfellows Caves on the Limestone Coast.

The survey work included the pegging of the new road alignment, to facilitate construction and sealing of the road by Council, and road acquisition surveys to facilitate the transfer of land for road purposes.

Boundary Re-establishment in Mid-North country towns

The undertaking of cadastral surveys for local government to re-establish and mark the boundaries of approximately 130 allotments in 2 Mid-North country towns, which had been surveyed initially in the 1870's.

Paradise Resthaven Nursing Home

Supervision of engineering survey work for a large nursing home, to facilitate architectural design work of a major upgrade to the site and assist with future site planning.
